PASSPORT

Go online to: <http://travel.state.gov/passport>

- Complete the online application and print off.
- Take your application, driver license, and *certified* Birth Certificate to your main Post Office where they will take your picture and send off your application.
- Approximate cost - \$115
- It may take up to 3 months to receive your passport via mail. If you are just now applying, you may want to discuss with the Post Office your options of quick processing.

VISA

Purchase VISA at Nairobi airport

- When you arrive at the Nairobi airport there is a line for "VISA".
- Approximate cost \$25-\$50. Use NEW U.S. bills!

UPDATE VACCINATIONS

- Contact your County Health Dept for Vaccination requirements. For Mesa County contact Judith at 970.248.6919.
- Check with your insurance company for coverage. Depending on your coverage cost may be less.
- Recommended vaccinations:
 - Tetanus
 - Hep A & B (3 sets needed)
 - Malaria – pills prescribed by your doctor or Holistic spray purchased via internet
 - Meningitis
 - Polio
 - Typhoid
 - Yellow Fever

TRIP SUPPLIES

- Credit card/Cash – New U.S. Bills (no more than 3 yrs old)
- Drivers license/ passport/vaccinations records/copy of your itinerary
- Medicines you may need
- Camera/extra batteries
- Bible/pen/journal
- Sandals/tennis shoes
- Light jacket or sweater
- New money for Visa if you do not already have it
- T-shirts/Jeans/shorts – Women (2) long skirts to ankles
- Towel
- Toiletries (soap/shampoo/tp)
- Sunglasses/sunscreen/hat
- Pocket size hand sanitizer
- Work gloves

U.S. EMBASSY

- Register with the U.S. Embassy: <http://travel.state.gov>. Registration at the U.S. Embassy or Consulate (in the country you are visiting) makes your presence and whereabouts known, in case it is necessary for a consular officer to contact you in an emergency. During a disaster overseas, American consular officers can assist in evacuation were that to become necessary. But they cannot assist you if they do not know where you are.

RAISING SUPPORT

- Raising support is just another step to getting to where you believe the Lord wants you. A missionary in Southeast Asia says this about raising support: "God did not give us a spirit of fear! (2 Tim 1:7) Think about it...God has called you. So, who is it that would like you to be afraid of "doing what it takes" that you don't respond? Answer: the enemy, of course! Resist the temptation to allow the fear of support raising to paralyze you. Don't allow support raising to be the obstacle that keeps you from the field where God has called you to minister. Support raising means simply sharing with others the exciting vision that God has given you! When people hear your heart and God's call, they WILL get involved. Often financial support will come from sources that you did not expect. Embrace support raising as an exciting faith walk with God!" In short, let your daily prayer times be permeated with the sense that you are looking primarily to the Lord to provide your finances.
